Services of the Charitable Society for Sustainable Development

The Charitable Society for Sustainable Development provides a variety of services aimed at improving the quality of life and promoting sustainable development in local communities.

- These services include:
- Humanitarian aid: Providing food and relief support to needy families, especially in times of crisis and disasters
 - Training and Capacity Building: Providing workshops and training courses to enhance the personal and professional skills of individuals, which contributes to empowering them and improving their opportunities in the labor market.
 Financing development projects.
 Empowering individuals.

Based on the structure followed by the association, distributions and projects can be classified according to the three basic programs as follows:These services include:

- 1. <u>Humanitarian Aid Program:</u> Aims to provide basic needs for the most vulnerable families and individuals, and is divided into:
- Food Security: Includes the distribution of food rations and food baskets to ensure food security for needy families.
 - Health and Hygiene: Includes the distribution of health supplies, personal hygiene products, and health awareness to reduce the spread of diseases and promote sound health practices.
- Student Support: Focuses on providing school bags, stationery, and educational needs to ensure the continuity of education for needy students.

- 2. <u>Protection Program :</u> Focuses on providing psychosocial support to children and adolescents through:
- Child-friendly spaces: safe environments that provide educational, recreational, and awareness-raising activities for children.
 - Support for children and adolescents: includes awareness programs, psychological rehabilitation, and community empowerment to protect the most vulnerable groups.

3. Social and Economic Support Program:

Aims to enhance the financial independence of individuals and families through:

- Training: Providing training and vocational workshops to improve skills and increase employment opportunities.
- Empowerment: Supporting individuals with opportunities that enable them to build a sustainable economic future.
- Financing projects and initiatives: Providing grants or soft loans to enable individuals to establish small projects that contribute to improving their livelihood.


